

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

The Patrick County School Board has established school attendance areas. However, the Board permits the exercise of school choice within established parameters. Parents may enroll children in schools outside assigned attendance area provided classroom size (pupil/teacher) is not excessive and the parent provides transportation to school or nearest bus stop of the school of choice. However, situations may arise that will require the establishment of school attendance boundaries that do not allow a child to attend the school of his choice.
